FROM FR. JOHN

By the time we read this, the new Archbishop of Westminster will have been installed at Westminster Cathedral. Archbishop Richard Moth served first as Bishop of the Armed Forces, later as Bishop of Arundel and Brighton. We pray for him as he begins his new ministry in our country. We pray also for Cardinal Nichols, formerly our own Archbishop before his transfer to Westminster, as he begins his well- earned retirement.

One Wednesday, we begin the holy season of Lent, with our Ash Wednesday Masses. 10am at St Johns, 7pm at St Wulstans.

Lent is, of course, the season of penance and preparation for Easter. It's a good opportunity to rediscover the beautiful sacrament of reconciliation (confession) where, as Cardinal Kasper reminded us, we hear the words that every priest 'but no therapist can say. Your sins are forgiven. Go in peace.'

There are 3 opportunities a week for confession in our parishes, 10-11am Saturday, 5:30-5:45pm Saturdays and 6:30-6:55pm Wednesdays. Your anonymity is preserved by the grill in our confessional. Do try to come to confession during Lent.

We are also recommencing the early morning Masses on Fridays. 7am followed by breakfast in the community centre. We shall also celebrate the stations of the Cross on Friday evenings at 7pm, alternating between St Wulstans and St Johns."
